JobOne has a social mission to provide jobs for people with significant disabilities and we are able to do this because of our ability to run competitive businesses with services that consumers demand. Essentially, we utilize a hybrid of for-profit and not-for-profit business management practices.

Nowhere is this 'hybrid' more evident than at [Secure Document Solutions \(SDS\)](#). SDS is an [NAID](#) AAA certified provider of secure document shredding. We manage several hundred customers in the public, private, and government spheres. SDS employs roughly 30 individuals with disabilities who perform a variety of tasks such as: running routes with our drivers, sorting, shredding, material handling, and baling.

SDS is located in an underground storage facility that is nearly 50,000 sq. ft. The atmosphere is very energetic with tippers, sorting conveyors, shredders, balers, and material handling equipment aiding the workers to sort, shred, and bale thousands of pounds of paper each day.

We take pride in running this program in an efficient, effective professional manner, while keeping our mission in mind. Employees at SDS express a high level of job satisfaction due to the variety of jobs, constant activity, and higher levels of pay.
