Unique Equine Therapy Program Helps Develop Skills

Terry H. has a love for horses and was not feeling confident about himself and his work skills, so his sister signed him up for equinapy (horse-assisted therapy). Every week, he goes to the Sugar Creek Farm in Harrisonville, MO to participate in the program. It is a not-for-profit organization that serves adults with disabilities. Instructors are certified with NARHA (North American Riding Handicapped Association) and the program is a provider for the Kansas City Regional Office. Instructors develop a personalized lesson plan, which involves grooming and caring for the horse as well as developing bonds and improving self-esteem. Terry enjoys the program and bond with Beasy, his horse. The therapy has been building self-confidence with peer interactions and his work abilities with JobOne. He is now cleaning lunch room tables between breaks and continues to demonstrate progress. When asked about the program, Terry responded that soon he would be riding like John Wayne!
